

Remarks on board ship John Cruising in the Mozambique Channel
Remarks on board Sunday June 11

These 24 hours strong wind and
specially steering by the wind on
different tack at 5 PM saw a light
whale going quick lowered without
succeeding - Ship immediately in sight
Latitude $27^{\circ} 00'$
Longitude $35^{\circ} 10'$

Remarks on board Monday June 12
These 24 hours commenced with light
wind from SE all sail set by the wind
to the E - Middle cabin - latter part
strong wind from E and squally steering
to the SE saw Blackfish Latitude $26^{\circ} 40'$
Longitude $34^{\circ} 00'$

Remarks on board Tuesday June 13
These 24 hours light wind from SE
and squally steering by the wind
to the SE saw many Blackfish
Latitude $25^{\circ} 15'$
Longitude $34^{\circ} 50'$

Remarks on board Wednesday June 14
These 24 hours wind from every
point of the compass - very squally
with heavy rain - saw several
water spouts - at a distance
saw Blackfish Latitude $25^{\circ} 30'$
Longitude $35^{\circ} 20'$

Remarks on board Thursday June 15
These 24 hours commenced squally
middle light wind from SE and
steering by the wind to the W
at 5 AM saw the Land distant 40
miles latter part strong wind from W
all sail set to the South Latitude $26^{\circ} 10'$
Longitude $34^{\circ} 40'$

Remarks on board Friday June 16
These 24 hours commenced with strong
wind from E steering by the wind to the E
at 5 PM wind changed to SE in a heavy
squall - latter part strong wind with
heavy squally ship hove to to the E
Latitude $25^{\circ} 00'$
Longitude $34^{\circ} 40'$

Channel for Whales Thomas Howland Master 1837

Remarks on board Saturday June 17
These 24 hours commenced with heavy squally
from SE - Middle the same ship under short
sail - latter part strong wind and clear
made sail by the wind to the E - saw nothing
Latitude $25^{\circ} 41'$
Longitude $35^{\circ} 17'$

Remarks on board Sunday June 18
These 24 hours light air ranging from E to
SE all sail set steering in different directions
saw no Whales -
Latitude $25^{\circ} 16'$
Longitude $35^{\circ} 20'$

Remarks on board Monday June 19 1837
These 24 hours light wind from SE and
specially steering by the wind on different
tack - saw many Blackfish but no
Whales -
Then Observed

Remarks on board Tuesday June 20
These 24 hours light wind from SE and
clear all sail set steering to the SE and W
saw many Blackfish but no Whales -
One ship in sight -
Latitude $25^{\circ} 21'$
Longitude $34^{\circ} 30'$

Remarks on board Wednesday June 21
These 24 hours commenced with light wind
from SE all sail set to the SE at 4
PM saw ship Ann Perry had taken
a right whale a few days previous off
Delagoa Bay - latter part calm
Latitude $25^{\circ} 35'$
Longitude $33^{\circ} 50'$

Remarks on board Thursday June 22
These 24 hours light wind from SE all
sail set by the wind to the SE saw Humpback
and chased without success
Latitude $27^{\circ} 00'$
Longitude $34^{\circ} 10'$
