These 24 hours commenced with strong Gale from N and thick weather 2 Dips from 10 to the E at 8 PM wind changed to S in a squall of wind and rain at 12 changed to N E latter part strong wind all sail set to the S E saw Timber at 6 PM spoke the Zephyr had seen nothing

Remarks on board Sunday Sept 10

These 24 hours commenced with strong wind from N shifted N E till 6 PM then from 10 to the wind to the E latter part a Gale ship under storm sail

These 24 hours commenced with a Gale from N W ship from 10 to the N E latter part wind W and squally at 8 PM were ship to the V - Latitude 34° 10

These 24 hours commenced with a Gale from W ship from 10 to under close reef of M Topsails and staysails to the N Middle masts moderate latter part calm saw Timber find a strong current setting N E
