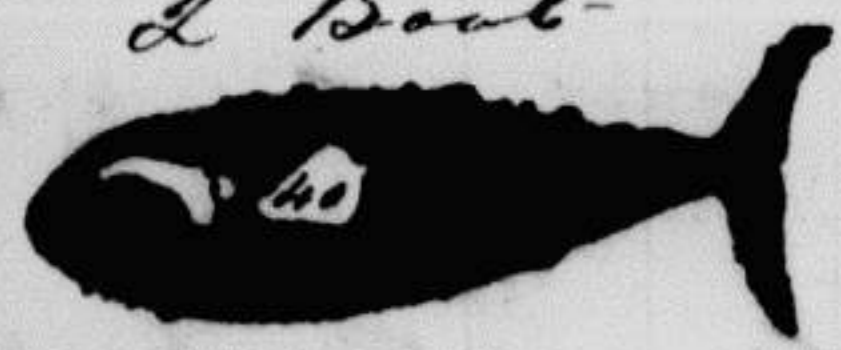

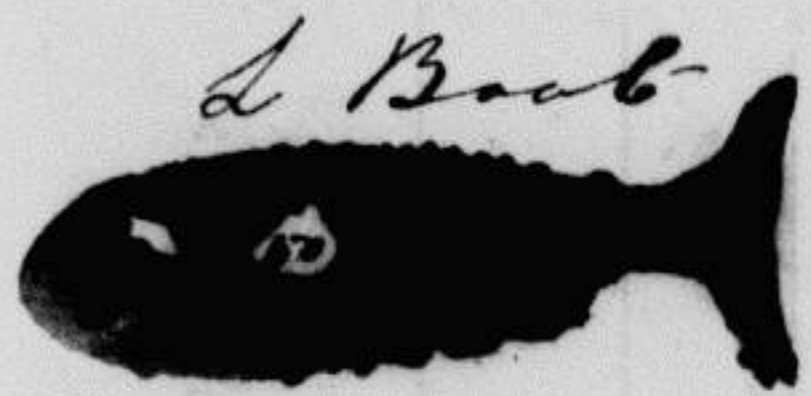


Remarks on Board Friday Dec 1 1837
