These 24 hours commenced with fresh
breeze from E all sail set course NE
by compass - Middle squally -
latter part light breeze from SE
and clear weather

These 24 hours light wind varying
from ESE to ENE and squally

These 24 hours commenced with strong
wind from VSW and clear all
sail set course NE - Middle
the same - latter part wind NE and
cloudy with squally and rain at
10 A.M. took in 5 Gallant sails
and put away in the topsails
at 12 M. day saw a large ship under
full mast by the wind to the SE

Remarks on board Friday March 2

These 24 hours commenced with light
wind from W and thick squally weather
with rain - Middle the same - standing
by the wind to the SE - latter part
light wind from NE and heavy
squall all sail set by the wind to
the NE - at 7 A.M. spoke ship
which of course from Liverpool
bound to Havre
