This 24 hours commenced with a Gale from N.W. and heavy sea ship drove to the N.W. under close reefed topsails at 4 P.M. which N.W. was ship to the S. and set Stairsail Middle and latter part main mast at 6 P.M. set Fore and Main poles at 6 A.M. let an reef from the top and set gills and spinnaker

This 24 hours commenced with strong wind from N.W. and rough sea steering by the wind to the S. and single reefed - at 4 P.M. passed a Brig steering same way - Middle and light wind and clear weather all sail set steering by the wind S. another Brig in sight ahead

This 24 hours commenced with light wind from N.W. and clear all sail set by the wind to the S. Middle Color latter part strong wind from N. and squally came S.W. by Campa at 10 A.M. saw a ship by the wind to the E. which had the appearance of a Man of War
