Comes in with strong breezes from the Northward the Bark steering to the E. by S. middle part the same latter part more moderate Henry Hazeltine off duty sick with Dry sentary No dgs

Wednesday March 31st

These twenty four hours fine weather and strong breeze from the North Middle and latter part foggy and hazy saw nothing one man sick

Lat 38.14 S Long 73.23 E

Thursday April 1st

This day Comes in with fresh breeze from the North the Bark steering E. by S. half South middle part rainy. latter part wind veering to the Westward and moderating with plenty of rain. one man sick

Lat 38.07 S Long 76.36 East

Friday April 2^d

At these twenty four hours fine weather and moderate breeze from North East the Ship steering by the wind to the S. by E. at 10 A.M. saw the Island of Amsterdam bearing E. by S. 15 miles. at ends with fine weather. one man sick

Saturday April 3^d

This day Comes in with fine weather and moderate breezes from N. E. the Bark laying off on at Amsterdam two Boats R. fishing at sunset came on Board bringing about 2 barrels of fish. middle part laying off on at daylight went in with 2 Boats, came on Board about noon with 2 Barrels of fish took up the Boats and stored.

Sunday April 4th

all these twenty four hours fresh breezes from N. E. the Bark steering East S. middle & latter part squally. saw killers & porpoises one man sick

Monday April 5th 1838

This day Comes in with strong breezes from N. W. the Bark steering to the E. by S. middle and latter part squally & rainy saw nothing. one man off duty sick No dgs.

Tuesday April 6th

Comes in with rain weather and variable winds the Bark steering E. middle part calm & clear latter part fine breeze from S. W. saw porpoises

Wednesday April 7th

These twenty four hours fresh breezes from S. W. the Bark steering East Middle and latter part much the same. saw nothing.

Thursday April 8th

all these twenty four hours strong breezes from W. S. W. steering to the E. by S. middle and latter part wind from the Southward saw no backs. Henry Hazeltine is well and gone to duty.

Friday April 9th

This day Comes in with light breezes from South the Bark steering East by South middle and latter part much the same saw nothing but porpoises two men sick

Lat 34.50 S Long 95.04 East

Saturday April 10th

This day Comes in with light breeze from South the Bark steering E. by S. middle part much the same latter part calm saw nothing. two men sick

Lat 33.44 South Long 96.33 East

Sunday April 11th

Comes in with light breezes from the North East the Bark steering E. by S. middle part calm, latter part light Westery breeze. saw porpoises. two men off duty sick

Lat 33.41 S Long 97.35 East

Monday April 12th

Comes in with fresh breeze from N. E. steering East middle and latter part the same saw no backs and porpoises
