Monday Sept 20<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with light breeze from S.E. the Bark standing to the West at 2 P.M. spoke the Slooping, with 200, this season, at St. Pells party Company, latter part standing to the S.E. saw finbacks, two vessels in sight the Slooping, & a Bark to windward running off free, ends with moderate weather,

Tuesday Sept 21<sup>st</sup>

Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from S.E. the Bark standing to the S.W. Middle part light breeze, saw nothing, ends with light breeze, employed getting up the head rigging, fitted a new Vildmuskup.

Wednesday Sept 22<sup>nd</sup>

All these twenty four hours fine weather and moderate breeze from S.W. the Bark standing to the Southward, at 3 P.M. spoke the Bark Mars & Ship Slooping, latter part standing to the Westward, wind from S.W. saw finbacks & porpoises, employed making Spun yarn

Lat 25.06 Long 111.41 E

Thursday Sept 23<sup>rd</sup>

This day comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from S.W. the Bark standing to the Westward at 4 P.M. spoke the Bark Oriole of Fairhaven latter part standing to the Eastward. Saw finbacks

Lat 25.17 Long 111.22

Friday Sept 24<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with fresh breezes from S.W. the Bark standing to the Eastward Middle and latter part much the same, saw finbacks, several vessels in sight. Employed working on the rigging and several other jobs

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Saturday Sept 25<sup>th</sup> 1838

This day comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from S.W. the Bark standing to the S.E. Middle and latter part much the same, saw nothing employed fitting a new Boatstay, Strap. Cut a hole through the stem and put a Chain Strap through

Lat 25.11 Long 111.15 E

Sunday Sept 26

All these twenty four hours fine weather & light winds from the S.W. the Bark standing to the Eastward. Middle part standing S.W. latter part standing to the Southward, the wind from W.S.W. a Bark in sight to the S.W. saw finbacks & Porpoises, one man off duty sick,

Lat 25.17 Long 111.00 E

Monday Sept 27<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with light breeze from South the Bark standing to the Westward in Company with the Bark Susitiam Middle and latter part quite a fresh breeze, saw nothing one Boatstuser and a man forward sick with Dysentery

Tuesday Sept 28<sup>th</sup>

First part of these twenty four hours fresh Breezes & specially rainy weather quite a fresh breeze from the South the Bark standing to the S.W. Middle & latter part much the same latter part running off both saw a Merchant Ship, & the Oriole, the sick man about the same

Wednesday Sept 29<sup>th</sup>

This day comes in with fine weather and light breezes from S.E. Middle & latter part much the same, saw nothing of the fish kind. Antoine one of our Boatstusers quit sick

Lat 25.00 Long 110.00

Thursday Sept 30<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from South the Bark standing to the Eastward. Middle & latter part fresh breeze, passed the Bark Oriole, standing to the S.W. the watch employed fitting new M. top Gallt. Boatstays the sick man some better,
