Monday Feb 28th 1857

This day Employed all hands getting water and Stowing it away. Setting up
Shocks, Stowing wood & Several other jobs.

Tuesday March 1st

Came in with fine Weather. the Watch ashore on liberty for twenty four hours
the Watch on board Employed Setting up Shocks for water one watch on
shore on liberty.

Wednesday March 2nd

Came in with fine Clear weather Employed Setting up Shocks for water
finished and Stowed down 100 barrels of water. Stowed away watch, one
Watch ashore on liberty.

Thursday March 3rd

This day Employed Smocking Ship. to kill rats one Watch ashore
on liberty.

Friday March 4th

This day Employed Washing Ship. getting water and Stowing it
away. one watch ashore on liberty.

Saturday March 5th

Employed getting off recruits Received on board fifty pickles of Sweet
Potatoes 26 doz of Irish potatoes rice and onions and Several other things
one watch ashore on liberty.

Sunday March 6th

one Watch ashore on liberty. Ends with fine Weather

Monday March 7th

This day Employed getting off recruits and getting ready for sea
Ends with fine breeze from the Northward.

Tuesday March 8th

This day Comes in with fine weather and light breeze from S.E.
at 2 P.M. got under weigh with light air from the North.

Wednesday March 9th

Came in with light breeze from the North the Bark Steering
S.E. Middle part Calm latter part light air from the Westward at Noon
point of view bearing N.W.

Thursday March 10th 1857

Came in with light breezes from the Southward the Bark Standing to the Eastward
Middle and latter part Calm at Noon the South West point of Java bearing N.W. 12 Miles

Friday March 11th

This day Comes in with fine weather and light breeze from S.E. the
Bark Standing by the wind to the South Middle and latter part Calm
Saw a Shoal of Blackfish lowered for them and brought one
Lat 7.55.

Saturday March 12th

Came in with light air from S.E. the Bark Standing to the South
Middle part steering S.E. with light breeze from S.W.
Employed boiling Blackfish blubber. Saw nothing. two men
off duty Sick with the Dysentery
Lat 7.55 Long 114.34

Sunday March 13th

This day Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze
from S.E. the Bark Steering S.E. Middle and
latter part the wind very light. Saw nothing. the sick ones
about the same
Lat 10.00 Long 114.49

Monday March 14th

All this day fine weather and light breeze from S.E. the
Bark Steering S.E. Middle part Moderate breeze from South, latter part
partly Calm. Saw one Cinchona.
Lat 10.23 Long 115.07

Tuesday March 15th

This day Comes in with fine weather and light breezes from S.W.
Steering S. by E. Saw nothing. Employed making 1 punyan
the Cooper Making Casks
Lat 10.31 Long 116.04
