

Bark John A. Robb Cruising on New Holland

Friday July 15th 1889

This day Comes in with fresh gales from S.W. the Bark laying to heading to the S.W. Middle and latter part much the same, the Watch Employed Storing oil in the fore hold. finished about noon.

Lat 21.16 Long 104.07

Saturday July 16th

These twenty four hours moderate breezes from the Eastward Steering by the wind to the S.W. Saw nothing but fimbriae latter part fine weather, the Cooper repairing Casks.

Lat 21.30 Long 103.10

Sunday July 17th

Comes in with fine weather and moderate breezes from the Eastward, Steering by the wind the S.W. at Sunset tacked to the N.E. Middle part much the same. Saw nothing, Wm. Coome Sick.

Lat 22.10 Long 104.00

Monday July 18th

These twenty four hours fine weather and light breezes from the S.E. the Bark Steering to the S.W. at daylight Wore round to the Eastward two vessels in sight to windward, Cooper repairing Cask.

Lat 22.40 Long 104.20

Tuesday July 19th

Comes in with fresh breeze from S.E. the Bark Steering by the wind to the Southward middle and latter part squally, two vessels in sight. Spoke the Bark Europa No obs.

Wednesday July 20th

Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze the Bark Steering by the wind to the Southward Saw nothing of the fresh kind, the Bark Europa in sight to the leeward, one man off duty Sick.

Lat 22.44 Long 103.15

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Thursday July 21st

Comes in with fine weather and fresh breezes from S.E. Spoke the Bark Europa and gave her three Casks of water. Middle part more moderate, Saw fimbriae.

Lat 22.35 Long 103.46

Friday July 22nd

These twenty four hours fine weather and moderate breezes from the Eastward Steering to the Northward. Saw fimbriae, the Sick man about the same Employed repairing the mainmast,

Lat 21.59 Long 103.56

Saturday July 23rd

Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from S.E. Steering on the Southern tack, Saw fimbriae one vessel in sight, two men off duty one Sick the other with a sore hand jammed with a Cask.

Lat 21.40 Long 104.04

Sunday July 24th

Comes in with fine weather and fresh breezes from the Eastward Steering by the wind to the N.E. Middle and latter part squally, Saw nothing two men off duty Sick.

Lat 21.40 Long 103.55

Monday July 25th

This day Comes in with strong breezes from S.E. the Bark Steering by the wind to the Eastward under Short Sail Middle, and latter part much the same, Saw nothing.

Lat 22.10 Long 104.38

Tuesday July 26th

These twenty four hours fine weather and strong breezes from the Eastward Steering by the wind to the N.E. middle and latter part more moderate Saw fimbriae.
