

Bark John A. Robb Cruising on New Holland

Monday Aug 8th

Comes in with fresh breezes from the South the Bark on the Southern tack Middle and latter part more moderate saw two vessels steering to the Eastward, at 7 A.M. tacked to the Eastward and tacked again at 10 A.M. the sick man about the same
Lat 22.46th Long 103.30th

Tuesday Aug 9th

This day Comes in with light Breezes from the South the Bark standing to the S.W. by the wind Middle and latter part much the same. three vessels in sight
Mr. Keene is getting a little better
Ends with moderate breeze
Lat 22.50 Long 104.20

Wednesday Aug 10th

Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from South steering by the wind to the N.W. middle and latter part much the same saw nothing of the fish kind. two whalers in sight one boiling, passed two Merchantmen steering to the Northward
Lat 22.46 Long 103.25

Thursday Aug 11th

Comes in with fine weather and light breezes from the W. steering to the N.W. spoke the Elisha Dinkar Middle part nearly calm latter part, light breezes saw nothing
Lat 22.35 Long 103.00

Friday Aug 12th

Comes in with gentle Breezes from the Westward the Bark standing to the S.W. Middle and latter part much the same saw nothing employed repairing the mainsail James. Nichols off duty Sick, Mr. Keene about the same
Lat 23.15 S Long 104.19th

Saturday Aug 13th

This day Comes in with fine weather and light breeze from the Westward steering to the S.E. middle and latter part much the same saw nothing. Ends with fresh breeze from S.W. the sick man about the same
Lat 23.27 Long 104.46

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Sunday Aug 14th 1859

These twenty four hours fresh breezes from S.W. the Bark steering to the North East Middle part a little more moderate saw nothing
Ends with moderate breeze from South the sick man about the same,
No Sick

Monday Aug 15th

Comes in with light breezes from South steering by the wind to the Eastward Middle part quite a fresh breeze from the Westward saw nothing. Ends with fresh westerly gale,
Dr. Nichols, well and gone today
Lat 22.55 Long 106.42

Tuesday Aug 16th

This day fresh gales from S.W. steering S.E. at sunset Shortland laid and luffed to the Wind heading to the South at day light wore round heading to the N.W. latter part rather more moderate. Saw a few finbacks.
Lat 22.57 Long 107.53.

Wednesday Aug 17th

Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from S.E. the Bark steering to the Westward, at 7 A.M. wore ship heading to the E.N.E. ends with fine weather. saw nothing employed repairing the Mizen topmast staysail Mr. Keene is not getting any better
Lat 22.46 Long 105.45 E.

Thursday Aug 18th

This day Comes in with a good whol sail breeze from S.E. steering to the Eastward by the wind middle and latter part much the same saw nothing. Ends with southerly winds. the sick man about the same
Lat 22.47 Long 106.19 E

Friday Aug 19th

This day Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from S.E. steering by the wind to the S.W. Middle and latter part much the same saw nothing.
Lat 22.30 Long 106.22 E
