

Bark John A Robb Cruising for Whales.

Wednesday Jan 25<sup>th</sup> 1860  
Comes in with fresh Gales from S.E. the  
Bark heading to the S.W. at Sunset tacked ship  
latter part heading South laying too under close  
reefed topsails, & saw nothing. Lat 34.40 Long 113.41

Thursday Jan 26<sup>th</sup>  
This day Comes in with moderate Breeze from  
S.E. middle and latter part fine Weather at 1 P.M. saw  
Whales, going quick to the N.W. lower for them without  
Success. Lat 34.17 Long 113.52

Friday Jan 27<sup>th</sup>  
Comes in with fine moderate weather the Barks in view  
of Whales, at Sunset gave them up and went on board -  
Middle and latter part fresh Gales. a Ship in sight  
to the Southward Lat 34.07 Long 114.27

Saturday Jan 28<sup>th</sup>  
Comes in with fine Weather and fresh Breeze  
from S.W. Steaming by the Wind to the Southward  
at Sunset spoke Ship, Alonzo of Edgartown from  
Desolation, reports the ships then having done nothing

Sunday Jan 29<sup>th</sup>  
Comes in with light weather and pleasant breeze from  
the S.E. Steaming to the S.W. the Alonzo in sight  
to leeward. at noon the land in sight bearing East  
Lat 34.31 Long 114.30

Monday 30<sup>th</sup>  
Comes in with fine Weather and moderate  
Breeze from the S.W. Steaming by wind to the S.W.  
Saw a large Steamer Steaming by the Wind to the S.E.

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Tuesday Jan 31<sup>st</sup> 1860  
This day Comes in with fine Weather the Bark Steaming  
to the N.W. middle and latter part much the same  
Saw a Ship Steaming to the N.W. Ends with strong breeze  
Lat 34.31 Long 114.41

Wednesday Feb 1<sup>st</sup>  
This day Comes in with fresh Breezes from the  
S.E. middle and latter part much the same, at 3 P.M.  
Anchored at Port Vasser, and fired the Ship,  
the Bark Eagle and Dido in Port

Thursday Feb 2<sup>nd</sup> 1860  
Fine Weather and pleasant Breezes from S.E.  
Middle and latter part much the same, at 7 A.M.  
got under weigh, and at 1 P.M. let go Anchor at  
Brimbury in four fathoms, and furled the sails

Friday Feb 3<sup>rd</sup>  
This day Employed breaking out Water and setting up  
Shooks for Water, filled four large pipes and took it on board

Saturday Feb 4<sup>th</sup>  
This day Employed setting up Shooks for Water  
got off a raft of fifty barrells of water and stowed it away

Sunday Feb 5<sup>th</sup>  
Comes in with fine Weather and pleasant breezes from  
S.E. Steaming, latter part Calm  
Monday Feb 6<sup>th</sup>  
This day fine Weather and pleasant breeze Employed setting  
up Shooks for Water finished and sent them ashore  
took off a raft of about 60 barrels and stowed it away.

Tuesday Feb 7<sup>th</sup>  
This day Comes in with pleasant Weather the Bark  
laying in Brimbury Employed filling brace blocks & cleaning bot  
toms & other jobs
