Wednesday Feb 8th

Comes in with fine weather, one Watch ashore on liberty. Come on board at day light, and sent the other watch on shore,

Thursday Feb 9th

This day the Starboard Watch on shore on liberty. Employed, fitting the Slings of the main yard, and Sundry Jobs,

Friday Feb 10

This day Employed fitting Slings of Fore and main yard. Topped Sheets &c one Watch ashore on liberty,

Saturday Feb 11th

This day Comes in with fine weather the Starboard Watch ashore on liberty, the other Watch Employed taking on board potatoes, and Stowing them away -

Sunday Feb 12th

Fine weather and pleasant breeze the Bark lying in port one Watch ashore on liberty,

Monday Feb 13th

Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze, Employed getting off water and painting brought on board 5 Sacks of onions

Tuesday Feb 14

Employed taking on board recruits one watch ashore on liberty, Cooper and Henry Hazeltine put in sail for being intoxicated

Wednesday Feb 15th

This day pleasant weather, the Starboard Watch ashore on liberty,

Thursday Feb 16th

Fine weather and pleasant breeze the Watch ashore on liberty

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Cruising for Whales.

Friday Feb 17th 1860

Fine weather and pleasant breeze from S.W. one Watch ashore on liberty, Employed Stowing away recruits. James Nichols, Wm. Kne and Henry Hazeltine in jail for being drunk

Saturday Feb 18th

Comes in with pleasant weather one Watch ashore on liberty. Employed getting off Wood and recruits,

Sunday Feb 19th

Fine weather and pleasant breeze, one Watch ashore on liberty

Monday Feb 20th

Comes in with fine weather, one boats crew off fishing, another getting iron poles, and bringing off water the three men in sail was taken out this afternoon and sent on board,

Tuesday Feb 21st

Comes in with fine weather and light breeze off the Land, at 9 A.M. got under weigh and at noon Bumbury bearing E. 20 miles

Wednesday Feb 22^d

Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from S.E. Standing to the W.N.W. by the Wind. Saw nothing in sight

Thursday Feb 23^d

Commences with fresh breeze from the W.S.W. Standing to the N.W. Middle and latter part much the same Saw nothing but one finback
