

Bark John A. Robb Cruising for Whales

Thursday May 3^d 1860

Came in with fine weather and moderate breeze from the S. S. E. Steering to the S. W. Spoke the Roman, saw a Bark in Chase of a large Whale, did not lower for him
Lat 23.17 Long 105.05

Friday May 4th

This day Comes in with fresh breeze from the S. S. E. the Bark Steering to the N. E. Middle and latter part much the same
Lat 23.10 Long 104.30

Saturday May 5th

This day Comes in with fresh breeze from the S. S. E. Steering by the Wind to the North Eastward. Several vessels in sight latter part wind E. N. E. Saw no fish
Lat 22.35 Long 103.46

Sunday May 6th

Come in with fine weather and moderate breeze from the Westward Steering E. S. E. Saw nothing Middle and latter part much the same
Lat 22.06 Long 104.19

Monday May 7th

First part light Winds from the S. E. the Bark Steering E. S. E. Middle and latter part much the same Saw killed one vessel in sight
Lat 22.51 Long 105.05

Tuesday May 8th

This day Comes in with fresh breezes from S. S. W. Steering E. S. E. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw porpoises and other small fry.
Lat 23.00 Long 106.10

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Wednesday May 9th 1860

Come in with fresh Breezes from the S. S. E. Steering by the Wind to the Eastward Middle and latter part much the same Saw no fish, Spoke Bark Champion.

Thursday May 10th

Come in with fine weather and moderate breeze from the S. S. E. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of the Whales, two ships in sight.
Lat 23.00 Long 106.26

Friday May 11th

First part moderate breeze from the S. S. E. Middle and latter part fresh trades Steering to the Westward Saw nothing.
Lat 23.25 Long 105.09

Saturday May 12th

This day Comes in with fresh breezes from the S. S. W. the Bark Steering off to the Westward Middle and latter part much the same two vessels in sight.
Lat 22.42

Sunday May 13

This day Comes in with fresh breezes from the South the Bark heading S. W. by W. Spoke Bark Messenger Middle and latter part much the same

Monday May 14th

Come in with strong breeze and squally weather heading to the Westward. Middle and latter part much the same
Lat 23.17 Long 105.15
