Wednesday June 20th

This day Comes in with fresh breeze and Squally weather the Bark heading to the S.E. by the wind on the larboard tack, Saw furbacks at 4 P.M. Spoke the Ship Parachute, latter part heading South, Capt Baker is Sick with the Dysentery, Mr Silvia is about the same Anton is well again and gone to duty.

Lat 22.06 Long 105.45

Thursday June 21st

First part fresh breeze from W.S.W. heading to the South Middle and latter part Squally, Saw nothing of the fish kind, a Ship in sight off the lee Bow heading to the

Eastward, Capt Baker is rather worse today Mr Silvia about the same, the Watch Employed repairing the Starboard pump, breaking out water again Sunday Jobs.

Lat 22.37 Long 106.01

Friday June 22^d

These twenty four hours fresh gales and Squally weather the Bark heading to the Westward Spoke the Parachute a Bark in sight heading to the S.E. Capt Baker is rather worse this day than he has been yet, Mr Silvia improving some, repaired the pump

Lat 22.40 Long 106.05

Saturday June 23^d

Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from South Middle and latter part much the same, Saw a large Merchantman steering North, Capt Baker is no better, this day.

Lat 22.12 Long 106.17.5

Sunday June 24th

Comes in with fresh gale from S.S.E. Middle and latter part Squally two vessels in sight steering to the Westward Capt Baker some better Mr Silvia about the same

Lat 22.50 Long 106.30

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Monday June 25th

Comes in with fine weather and moderate breeze from S.S.E. heading to the S.W. by the Wind Middle and latter part much the same Spoke the Bark Messenger, The Eagle and Champion, and Eliza Dunbar in sight.

Lat 23.01 Long 104.46

Tuesday June 26th

These twenty four hours fresh breeze and Squally weather the Bark heading to the S.E. two vessels in sight, Saw a few furbacks, the watch Employed repairing the fore top-sail, bent it at 4 P.M. Saw no Whales, Capt Baker is some better Mr Silvia also

Lat 22.33 Long 105.31.5

Wednesday June 27th

First part moderate breeze from North heading to the Westward Middle and latter part fresh breeze Spoke Bark Eagle latter part rainy Saw furbacks.

No stop.

Thursday June 28th

This day Comes in with fresh breeze from W.S.W. Middle and latter part wind from S.W. steering N.W. under close reefed top-sails, middle rainy Saw the Eagle, Capt Baker seems to be getting worse, Mr Silvia about the same

No stop.

Friday June 29th

Comes in with fresh breezes from South heading to the Westward middle and latter part much the same Saw nothing, latter part steering N.W. with fore top-sail shot out, Capt Baker some better, Mr Silvia about the same

Lat 21.51 Long 103.30

Saturday June 30th

Comes in with strong trades and Squally weather the Bark steering W.S.W. Saw nothing, Middle part more moderate. Capt Baker is about the same.

Lat 20.57 Long 101.00
