Sunday July 1<sup>st</sup> 1860

Three times by four hours fresh Trades and Squally  
the Bark Steering W. by N. Middle and latter part  
the Wind bearing to the S.E. Saw finbacks. The Sick  
one a little better.

Monday July 2<sup>d</sup>

Came in with fresh breezes Steering W. by N. Middle  
and latter part much the same. Saw finbacks  
The Capt and second mate about the same

Lat 20.29 Long 73.57

Tuesday July 3<sup>d</sup>

Three twenty four hours fine weather and  
fresh Trades Steering West to South Saw  
nothing. the Watch Employed setting up fore &  
main top-mast rigging Main top gall backstays. Capt  
Baker about the same. Lat 20.12 Long 70.47

Wednesday July 4<sup>th</sup>

Fresh trades and clear weather Steering  
W. by N. Saw nothing. Capt Baker is  
a little better this morning. Mr. Silvia about the  
same. Lat 20.07 Long 67.11

Thursday July 5<sup>th</sup>

Came in with fresh Trades, and Breeze to  
Weather Steering W. by N. Middle and latter  
part more moderate. Saw nothing. Capt Baker  
about the same. Mr. Silvia improving some

Lat 20.00 Long 64.20

Friday July 6<sup>th</sup>

Three twenty four hours fresh Trades from S.E.  
Steering W. by N. Middle and latter part much  
the same. Bent a main royal and sent the yard afloat  
Capt Baker rather worse. Mr. Silvia about the same

Saturday July 7<sup>th</sup> 1860

This day Comes in with fresh Trades and Squally  
Weather the Bark Steering W. by N. Middle and  
latter part much the same. Capt Baker is rather  
worse again Mr. Silvia about the same

Lat 19.58 Long 77.18

Sunday July 8<sup>th</sup> 1860

Three twenty four hours fresh Trades and clear  
Weather Steering W. by N. Saw nothing. Ends with  
steady breezes. The sick ones about the same

Lat 20.00 Long 73.31

Monday July 9<sup>th</sup>

First part fresh Trades and Squally Weather  
the Bark Steering W. by N. Middle part moderate  
latter part fresh Trade winds. Saw a finback

Lat 20.06 Long 70.31

Tuesday July 10<sup>th</sup>

Came in with fine weather and moderate  
Breeze from E. Steering W. by N. Saw nothing.  
Employed setting rigging. Ends with moderate  
trades. The Sick ones improving some.

Lat 20.00 Long 67.56  
Lunars 68.50

Wednesday July 11<sup>th</sup>

Three twenty four hours fine weather and moderate  
Breeze from East Steering W. by N. Employed broking  
out Water and Sunday Lobs Saw nothing.

Lat 19.48 Long by Chron 66.00  
Lunars 66.10

Thursday July 12<sup>th</sup>

This day Comes in with fine weather and  
light breeze from the Eastward at 10 A.M.  
Saw the Island of Rodriguez bearing W. by N. 4 miles  
Saw finbacks. Capt Baker improving  
some.
