Tuesday Aug 21st 1860

This day Comes in with fine Weather and moderate Breezes from S. E. by E. heading to the S. S. W. at daylight wore Ship and headed to the N. E. The Bark Eagle in sight on the same tack. Saw finbacks. The only Sick one we have now is Allen, and he is gaining slowly.

Lat 21.40. Long 106.45

Wednesday Aug 22nd 1860

This day Comes in with fresh breezes and squally Weather the Bark heading to the S. E. Middle and latter part much the same saw finbacks Allen is some better.

Lat 21.50 Long 57.00

Thursday Aug 23rd

These twenty four hours fine Weather and light Breezes from E. S. E. heading to the Southward saw finbacks and porpoises. Allen is some better.

Lat 22.45 Long Chron 57.22
Lunar 57.32

Friday Aug 24th

This day Comes in with fine Weather and light Winds heading by the Wind to the N. E. saw finbacks and porpoises. Loe Padilla got his foot sprained some hoisting the Boat, it caught between the Ship and the Boat.

Saturday Aug 25th

This day Comes in with light breezes from E. S. E. heading N. E. by the Wind. Saw finbacks. Latter part quite smooth Loe is some better Allen is well and goes to duty.

Lat 21.25 Long 57.23

Sunday Aug 26th

These twenty four hours fine Weather and moderate Breezes from E. S. E. heading S. E. by the Wind. Saw nothing Ends with light Breezes

Lat 22.09 Long 58.40

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Monday Aug 27th 1860

Comes in with light air from S. E. heading E. S. E. Middle and latter part light air from South. Saw nothing. Loe Padilla is getting some better with his lame foot

Lat 22.33 Long 58.52

Tuesday Aug 28th

First part fresh Gales from the South heading to the Eastward by the Wind. Latter part on the Southern tack same black fish and porpoises. Allen Sick again Loe, about the same

Lat 21.52 Long 59.22

Wednesday Aug 29th

These twenty four hours strong breezes and squally Weather heading to the Eastward. Middle and latter part much the same End with rainy Weather. Saw nothing

Thursday Aug 30th

This day Comes in with fresh Gale from S. E. the Bark laying to under Close reefed fore & main topsail heading to the Eastward at Sunset wore Ship heading to the S. S. W. Middle & latter part squally & rainy wore Ship to the Eastward. Saw nothing

No log,

Friday Aug 31st

Fresh Gale from S. E. heading to the Eastward, at 4 P.M. wore Ship to the South and took in the fore top sail. Middle and latter part a little more moderate saw two Merchantmen standing off to the Westward. Loe Padilla is well and goes to duty

Lat 22.08 Long 59.20

Saturday Sept 1st

This day Comes in with fresh breezes from East heading to the South Middle part more moderate Ends with strong Breezes saw one Ship standing off to Westward

Lat 22.15 Long 59.30
