Friday Nov 23^d

These twenty four hours fine Weather and moderate Breezes from the N.E. the Bark heading to the Westward. Saw nothing. Latter part Steering W.N.W. Employed fitting Boats Working on the Rigging and Sundry Jobs.

Lat 21.01 Long 53.29^E

Saturday Nov 24th

Comes in with fine Weather and moderate Breezes from the N.E. Steering W.N.W. Middle and latter part much the same. Latter part light air from N.E. Saw one Fin back

Lat 21.41 Long 51.48^E

Sunday Nov 25th

This day Comes in with fine Weather and moderate Breezes from the N.E. the Bark heading to the W.N.W. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing. The Sick men are improving some. The Sick ones remain about the same. Lat 22.30 Long 51.00

Monday Nov 26th

These twenty four hours fine Weather and moderate Breezes from N.E. Steering W.N.W. Saw nothing

Lat 23.10 Long 50.00^E

Tuesday Nov 27th

This day Comes in with fine Weather and moderate Breezes from the N.E. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing. Spoke the Ship Rover & Ocean

Lat 24.30 Long 49.11

Wednesday Nov 28th

Comes in with fine Weather and rough Weather. Breezes from the N.E. heading to the N.W. in Company with Rover. Received on Board from the Rover 60 barrels of old oil Sticks

Lat 24.12 Long 48.16

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Thursday Nov 29th 1860

These twenty four hours fresh Breezes from the N.E. Steering W.N.W. in Company with the Rover at 9 A.M. Spoke the Land bearing W by N. about 30 miles off. Capt Baker Sick with Dysentery. Lat 24.28. Long 47.45

Friday Nov 30th

Comes in with fine Weather and fresh Breezes from the N.E. the Bark Steering W.N.W. Spoke Bark Joseph Maxwell 13th Dec 1860. 400 Spenn. Fort Dauphin in sight about 40 Miles off.

Saturday Dec 1st

First part fine Weather and moderate Breeze from the N.E. Steering W.N.W. Middle and latter part fresh Breezes. Saw a Bark Steering to the Westward.

Lat 26.45 Long 45.36

Sunday Dec 2^d

This day fresh Breezes and squally Weather the Bark heading to the Westward Middle part under Short Sail. Ends with fine Weather. Capt Baker is some better.

Monday Dec 3rd

These twenty four hours fine Weather and moderate Breezes from the Southwestern. Middle and latter part much the same.

Lat 27.36 Long 42.36^E

Tuesday Dec 4th

These twenty four hours strong trades and squally Steering W. Saw nothing. Employed fitting Cutting Blocks. No obs.
