Saturday Dec 29<sup>th</sup>

Came in with strong S.E. Gale with heavy squalls Parted our Small Chain and lost the Small Anchor. at day light the weather Moderated a little got under way about 7 AM. Would not wait for the recovery of the Anchor as the weather looked threatening and the Anchor was not of much value

Sunday Dec 30<sup>th</sup>

These twenty four hours Fresh Gales from the S.E. the Bark Steering N.W. saw nothing Latter part more moderate turned the keels out of the topsails and set Main top Gallatails Lat 32.37 Long 142

Monday Dec 31

This day fresh Breezes from South Steering W.S.W. Middle part more Moderate. Ends with Fresh Breezes. Saw porpoises and Caught one No obs

Tuesday Jan 1<sup>st</sup> 1861

The New year Comes in with fine Weather and Moderate Breeze from the South East Middle and latter part much the same Saw nothing The watch making Spun yarn Lat 31.57 Long 146 E

Wednesday Jan 2<sup>d</sup>

This day light breezes and pleasant weather the Bark Steering W by N. Saw killers. The watch Employed rattled down the Main Rigging. Ends with good weather

Lat 31.18 Long 143 E

Thursday Jan 3<sup>d</sup>

These twenty four hours moderate weather and Clear Saw nothing of any consequence the watch at work on the fore and main Rigging Lat 32.21 Long 142 E

Friday Jan 4<sup>th</sup> 1861

Came in with fine Weather and moderate Breeze from the E.S.E. Steering West. Middle and latter part much the same Employed rattled down the Mizzen rigging Lat 33.00 Long 145 E

Saturday Jan 5<sup>th</sup>

These twenty four hours fine Weather and moderate Breeze from the South Middle and latter part the wind light and variable Saw porpoises The Watch Employed rattled down the Mizzen Rigging and Sundry Sails

Lat 33.47 S Long 142 E

Sunday Jan 6<sup>th</sup>

First part of this day light air from the Westward the Bark Steering to the Southward at sunset tacked Ship Middle and latter part moderate Breeze from the S.W. Saw nothing

Lat 33.27 Long 143 E

Monday Jan 7<sup>th</sup>

This day Comes in with moderate Breeze from S.W. Steering to the N.W. Middle and latter part the wind very light The watch Employed making rattles stuff for the fore Rigging

Lat 33.15 Long 142 E

Tuesday Jan 8<sup>th</sup>

These twenty four hours very light westerly winds the Bark heading to the N.W. at 5 P.M. Spoke the Bark Fairbank Steering to the North

Wednesday Jan 9<sup>th</sup>

all this day fine Weather and light westerly winds the Bark heading to the N.W. saw no fish of any kind Employed rattled down the main rigging
