Thursday Jan 10th 1861

Comes in with Calm Weather Middle part
light winds from S.W. the Bark heading on the
wind to the S.W. Ends with Calm Saw
plenty of small fry Lat 31.27 Long 00.23 E

Friday Jan 11th

This day Comes in with Calm Weather, and
light B'effling winds. Middle and latter
part much the same Saw nothing of importance
the watch employed rather down the line and
main Rigging. Lat 30.47 00.12 E

Saturday Jan 12th

These twenty four hours nearly Calm the
the whole time, and Ends with little prospect
of a Breeze, saw nothing but small fry,
finished setting down the lower rigging, one man
off duty sick Lat 30.16 Long

Sunday Jan 13th

These twenty four hours light air from
the Westward Steering S. N. E. Saw
porpoises and other small fry Jim
Nichols the Sick man is not getting any better
Lat 29.34 Long 0.21 E

Monday Jan 14th

First part of this day good weather and very light
Breezes Middle and latter part much the same
End with a little more wind, employed turning
up the M. Top, mast Back stays
Lat 28.16 Long 1.08 E

Tuesday Jan 15th

These twenty four hours Strong breeze
from the South. Steering to the Eastward
Middle and latter part Calm, and weather
Lat 27.12 Long 2.06 E

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Wednesday Jan 16th

These twenty four hours Strong Breeze
from South Steering E. N. E. the Bark
is heaving again pretty freely at the rate
of 5000, Strakes in twenty four hours E
Lat 25.33 Long 13.00

Thursday Jan 17th

Comes in with Strong Gale from the
South the Bark Steering E. by N. the Middle
part Squally latter part more moderate Saw
nothing as usual, Lat 24.09 Long 14.17 E

Friday Jan 18th

First part fresh Breezes from S. E. the
Bark Steering E. by S. Middle part Squally
Ends with moderate Weather Saw nothing,
Lat 22.57 Long 15.57 E

Saturday Jan 19th

These twenty four hours light southerly
Winds the Bark standing to the E. S. E. Ends
with Calm, Saw nothing at all,
Lat 22.29 Long 17.30 E

Sunday Jan 20th

These twenty four hours light
Breezes and Calm the Bark working
to the E. S. E. Saw nothing of any
description neither Birds nor fish. the
water is a light Green Color
Lat 22.29 Long 17.57 E

Monday Jan 21st

This day Comes in with light Breezes
from S. W. the Bark Steering to the E. S. E.
Middle part Squally Ends with Calm, Saw
porpoises Lat 22.22 Long 18.38 E
