Tuesday Jan 22<sup>nd</sup> 1861

This day Comes in with fine weather and moderate Breezes from S.W. the Bark works in to the S.W. E. Saw a few Grampuses and other small Fry

Lat 22.32 Long 8.45 E

Wednesday Jan 23<sup>rd</sup>

These twenty four hours fresh Breeze and Clear Weather. Middle and latter part a little more moderate. Saw nothing of any account

Lat 22.32 Long 09.15 E

Thursday Jan 24<sup>th</sup>

First part light Breeze from S.W. the Bark Standing to the Eastward. Middle part the weather quite moderate. Ends with fresh Breezes. Saw nothing

Lat 22.42 Long 9.35 E

Friday Jan 25<sup>th</sup>

This day Comes in with moderate Breeze from the Southward. the Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance

Lat 22.56 Long 9.10

Saturday Jan 26<sup>th</sup>

Comes in with fresh breezes from the S.W. the Bark on different tacks. Middle and latter part the weather about the same. Saw nothing

Lat 23.27 Long 08.45

Sunday Jan 27<sup>th</sup>

This day Comes in with fresh Breeze from S.W. the Bark Standing by the wind to the Eastward. Saw a Bark off the Cape Bearing at 4 P.M. spoke the Bark Washington of Sag Harbor

Monday Jan 28<sup>th</sup> 1861

This day Comes in with fresh Breeze from the S.W. Standing by the Wind to the Westward, all hands employed Coopers pipes of oil Between decks finished about sunset

Lat 23.10 Long 8.31 E

Tuesday Jan 29<sup>th</sup>

These twenty four hours fine weather and moderate Breezes from S.W. the Bark Standing to the Eastward middle and latter part the weather quite moderate. Saw nothing but one Furback.

Lat 23.02 Long 9.44

Wednesday Jan 30<sup>th</sup>

First part of these twenty four hours light winds from the Southward the Bark on the Eastern tack middle and latter part Standing to the Westward. Saw one Furback.

Lat 23.09 Long 9.16 E

Thursday Jan 31<sup>st</sup>

These twenty four hours fresh Breezes from the S.W. the Bark Standing off W. by S. Middle and latter part quite squally. Saw nothing at all worth noting

Lat 24.07 Long 08.06

Friday Feb 1<sup>st</sup>

Comes in with good wholsail Breeze from the South the Bark Standing W. by South. Middle part squally. Ends with fine weather. Saw porpoises. Jim Nichols still off duty Sick.

Lat 25.30 Long 11.57 E

Saturday Feb 2<sup>nd</sup>

This day fine weather and moderate Breezes Standing W. by S. Saw nothing of importance
