Sunday Feb. 3rd 1861

This day Comes in with Good wind and light Baffling winds Middle and latter part fresh Breeze from S.W. Saw small fry. Lat 27.00

Monday Feb. 4th

Comes in with fine weather and moderate Breezes from S.W. the Bark Steering to the Westward saw Grampuses and fin backs. latter part Steering W. Lat 27.45 Long 80.6

Tuesday Feb. 5th

First Part of this day fine weather and moderate wind from S.E. the Bark Steering W.S.W. Middle part the same. Ends with fresh Breezes. Saw one fin back. Lat 28.31 Long 83.5 W

Wednesday Feb. 6th

These twenty four hours fine weather and pleasant whole sail Breeze. Steering W.S.W. Saw Grampuses and porpoises but nothing larger. Lat 29.49 Long 85.5 W

Thursday Feb. 7th

Comes in with fine weather and moderate winds from the Southward the Bark Steering to the W.S.W. Middle part about the same latter part heading to the W.S.W. with rainy squally weather saw nothing. Lat

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Friday Feb. 8th 1861

Comes in with fresh Breezes from the South the Bark heading to the Westward Middle and latter part the weather about the same Steered off S.E. at daylight Saw nothing. No des.

Saturday Feb. 9th

Comes in with fresh Breezes from the South the Bark Steering S.E. by N. Middle part heading to the Westward. Latter part Steering N.E. by S. Saw nothing of importance

Sunday Feb. 10th

These twenty four hours light winds and pleasant weather the Bark Steering S.E. by N. Ends with light Breezes Saw absolutely nothing not the first thing. Lat 28.25 Long 2.33 W

Monday Feb. 11th

Comes in with fresh Breezes from the South Middle and latter part light winds. the Bark Steering S.E. by N. Saw Grampuses. Employed Scraping and painting iron work, set up the Tell stay

Tuesday Feb. 12th

Comes in with fine weather and moderate winds from the S.W. the Bark Steering S.E. by N. Middle and latter part much the same Employed Coopersing the oil Between Decks. Lat 27.36 E Long 2.04 E
