of importance.

Tuesday March 19th

Comes in with Good weather, and moderate
Winds from the S. E. the Bark Steering at
anchor, all hands Employed painting Ship and
Coopering oil,

Wednesday March 20th

Comes in with fine Weather and moderate
Winds from the S. E. all hands Employed painting
and Coopering oil and Stowing down oil.

Thursday March 21st

Comes in with rainy Weather the Bark
all hands Employed Stowing down oil and
meat. finished about 6 P. M.

Friday March 22nd

This day fine Weather and moderate Breezes
all hands Employed washing Ship one Watch
ashore on liberty for 24 hours

Comes in with rain Squalls, and fresh Trades
the Bark at anchor the Watch Employed painting
Spars and the head and Stern, one Watch
ashore on liberty.

Sunday March 24th

Comes in with rainy Weather and fresh Trades
one Watch ashore the other Watch Employed
for

Monday March 25th

This day fine Weather and moderate trades the
Bark at anchor. the Watch Employed painting one
Watch ashore, on liberty.

Tuesday March 26th

This day Comes in with fine Weather and
fresh Trades the Crew all hands Employed getting
off Water, and Stowing it away, finished
about dark.

Wednesday March 27th

This day Comes in with Good weather and moderate
trades at 11 AM. got under weigh with fresh Trades
middle and latter part much the same & saw
Several vessels. Ends with Good weather.
