Tuesday May 7th

Came in with light breeze from the Westward hauled
to the S.W. middle part, steering our course S.W. by
North, with the Wind from the N.E. middle and late
part much the same. Ends with fine breeze from
South. Employed painting the lower Rigging.
Lat 31.30 Long 66.16

Wednesday May 8th
First part of this day fresh breezes from
the Southward, steering S.W. Middle
and latter part rainy. Several vessels in
sight. Ends with rainy weather & noobs.

Thursday May 9th
This day Came in with fine weather and
fresh breezes from S.W. the Bark on the
Wind heading to the S.W. Middle and
latter part much the same. Saw Shrimps.
Lat 35.17 Long 68.41

Friday May 10th
This day Came in with fresh breezes from the
Westward, the Bark steering S.W. by the Wind at
7 AM. hauled heading N.W. by S. and backed again
about noon. Saw several vessels.
Lat 36.31 Long 68.22 W

Saturday May 11th
Came in with fresh breezes from the
S.W. steering S.W. Middle part rainy & heavy
squalls. the Bark under close reefed main top
and fore topmast staysail the Wind veering to the
South latter part shifted round to the N.W.
lost the Bow Boat. Stove by a sea boarding
her. Threw the try works over board.
Lat 37.44 Long 69.00 W

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Sunday May 12th

This day Came in with fine weather and fresh breezes
from the N.W. the Watch employed washing ship and Sunday
John. Middle and latter part moderate on vessel in sight
a fore & aft Schooner.
Lat 37.22 Long 69.01 W

Monday May 13th
Came in with fine weather and moderate winds
from the South. E. steering S.W. Middle and
latter part fresh breezes and rainy. Ends with
cloudy weather.
Lat 38.12
