

Saturday August 31st 1867
 Squally, with a strong wind from E. steering S. by W
 Squally all last night. Set up the main royal
 and topgallant backstays, this P.M. One sail is right
 Lat 7° 10' S Long 27° 38' W

Sunday September 1st
 Fair this A.M., squally this P.M., wind strong from
 E. steering S. by W. Saw a big gins N. also
 saw a finback. Under short bill this evening
 Lat 12° 00' S Long 33° 40' W

Monday September 2nd
 Fair, moderate wind from E. heading S. by W
 S. Squally and blowing strong most of the night
 At 9 P.M. double reefed the topsails. Took them
 out at 3 A.M. This forenoon hove out water
 and a new flying jib and bent it. This
 afternoon set up the lee fore rigging, and topmast
 topm backstays. Saw several finbacks
 Lat 14° 40' S Long 31° 35' W

Tuesday September 3rd
 Fair with a strong wind from E. steering
 full and by, heading S. by W. Set up the weather
 maintopmast backstays, this forenoon. Saw some
 humpbacks and finbacks. Saw from both
 watches lost their watch below for not knowing
 the half points on the compass.
 Lat 17° 20' S Long 32° 16' W

Wednesday Sept 4th
 Fair, with a strong wind from E. S. steering
 full and by, heading S. This morning very
 squally. At 6:45 A.M. raised beaches on
 point of the weather bow and proved to be
 humpbacks but did not chase for them
 Lat 19° 45' S Long 32° 25' W

Thursday September 5th 1867
 Cloudy with squalls of rain, wind from E. N.E.
 steering S.E. Engaged this forenoon in making
 topgallant and flying others for the latches
 Saw humpbacks and finbacks this forenoon
 Lat 22° 50' S Long 32° 14' W

Friday September 6th
 Fair, moderate wind from E. N.E. course S.E.
 Saw finbacks and porpoises, and beg this
 morning steering N. Engaged in setting
 up the main topgallant and royal
 backstays, main topgallant and royal
 fore and aft stays, and foretopgallant shrouds
 Lat 25° 15' S Long 31° 13' W

Saturday Sept 7th
 Fair, moderate wind from N.E. course S.E.
 At 6 A.M. set the studding sails. Engaged
 this forenoon in setting up the main topmast
 and topgallant rigging. Saw a finback
 Lat 26° 55' S Long 28° 42' W

Sunday Sept 8th
 Fair, with a full breeze from N. N. W. course
 S.E. Saw finbacks and porpoises this noon
 Lat 28° 30' S Long 26° 22' W

Monday Sept 9th
 Fair, moderate wind from N. W. course S.E. Saw two
 sails steering N.E. Put down foretop sail and
 gafftop sail mended and bent them
 Lat 29° 48' S Long 24° 14' W

Tuesday Sept 10th
 Cloudy, with a good breeze from N. W. course S.E.
 This A.M. sent down the mainsail mended and bent it
 Lat 31° 23' S Long 21° 23' W
