

Sunday November 17<sup>th</sup> 1867

Fair strong breeze from NE, course SW. Shifted the studding sails twice now on port side. At 2 P.M. raised land on our starboard beam. Saw fishbacks  
Lat 11° 40' N Long 52° 04' E

Monday Nov 18<sup>th</sup>

Fair, wind strong from NE, course SSW. Had a light squall of rain this forenoon. Engaged at getting up all the head staves. Land in sight on our starboard beam. Saw Arab dhows this forenoon. At 4 P.M. shifted studding sails to the port side.

Lat 11° 00' N Long 51° 27' E

Tuesday Nov 19<sup>th</sup>

Fair, wind strong from NE, course S by W. Engaged this forenoon at putting on hull line and deck line bolts on the foremast. Saw some albatrosses  
Lat 7° 57' N Long 51° 05' E

Wednesday Nov 20<sup>th</sup>

Fair, moderate wind from NE, course S by W. Broke out water this morning. Saw porpoises  
Lat 6° 00' N Long 50° 35' E

Thursday Nov 21<sup>st</sup>

Fair, wind moderate from NE, course S by W  
Lat 5° 25' N Long 51° 08' E

Friday Nov 22<sup>nd</sup>

Fair, wind light from NE, course S by W. Engaged at cleaning muzzles. At 4 P.M. raised a whaling big fair fisher off the weather. We were round for her. She was on the wind.

Lat 25 miles N Long 49° 32' E

Saturday Nov 23<sup>rd</sup> 1867

Fair, wind light from NE, course S by E. Had that big last night until 9 o'clock last night. Hunt-takes made of Petroleum oil, but she did not want to give. We all surmised that it was the shot produce of Fairhaven  
Lat 25 miles N Long 49° 32' E

Sunday Nov 24<sup>th</sup>

Fair, wind light from NE, course S by E. Had a light squall of rain this evening. Saw porpoises  
Lat 1° 00' S Long 50° 21' E

Monday Nov 25<sup>th</sup>

Fair, wind light from NE, course S by E. Engaged making a running for the main to stand mast-head under. Struck porpoise this evening and saved him  
Lat 2° 00' S Long 51° 57' E

Tuesday Nov 26<sup>th</sup>

Fair, and calm most all last night and today what there was came from NE, course S by E. Engaged at making a running for the ice.  
Lat 2° 45' S Long 52° 45' E

Wednesday Nov 27<sup>th</sup>

Calm all last night and today. Engaged in mending the mainmast and bubbling it again  
Lat 2° 47' S Long 53° 29' E

Thursday Nov 28<sup>th</sup>

Fair, had a calm all last night until this 4 P.M. when we had a breeze from SW, course S by E. Engaged this A.M. in making ship outside also had a good swim. This afternoon broke out water, also struck a porpoise and saved him  
Lat 2° 50' S Long 54° 28' E
