

Sunday December 24th

Equally, wind baffling Steaming North Engaged at
boiling our Whales. Killed a pig this afternoon
Bird Island on our lee beam 6 miles distant.

Tuesday Dec 25th

Equally, wind from N.W. Steaming full and by.
Finished trying out this morning. The two whales
made 62 Blb. 1 P.M. double edged tobaccos. At 6 P.M.
David Fisk raised a sperm whale. Sprinkled off the
weather bow going to the windward. Lowered for him
but it was dark in few minutes, after we
lowered. Dennis Id bore P.M. 10 miles distant

Wednesday Dec 26th

Equally this A.M. wind moderate from N.W.
Engaged at breaking out in the main hold
and stowing down oil in it. At 3:45 P.M.
Sham Eiford raised a school of sperm whales.
on our lee bow going to the windward
Lowered but did not succeed in getting fast
going to quick. Dennis Id bearing P.M. 10 miles

Thursday Dec 27th

Equally, wind moderate from N.W. Engaged this
A.M. in scrubbing ship. This 1 P.M. Capt. Hicks
and Mr. Anderson went ashore at Dennis Id
in the starboard boat, and returned again at
5:30 P.M. brought aboard chickens, two pigs, coconuts
and greens. A canoe from the Island came alongside

Friday Dec 28th

Fair, wind moderate from N. At 7 A.M. raised a
sail which proved to be the ship Lancer Capt.
Macy of New Bedford 32 months out with 1000 Blb
sperm. She had been to the coast of Akaba she saw
plenty whales at Bird and Dennis Islands
and Dennis and Bird Islands.

Sunday December 29th

Fair, strong breeze from N. At 2 P.M. engaged
with ship Lancer. Saw Bird and Dennis Islands

Monday Dec 30th

Fair, strong breeze from N.W. Engaged in washing
paintwork in storage. have been helping very hard
late. The ship Lancer left last night for
Port Dauphin. Dennis Id in sight this evening

Tuesday Dec 31st

Fair, with a strong breeze from N. All islands
the in sight this morning, except Bird which
is in sight this evening bearing P.M. 5 miles
distant Engaged at various jobs

Wednesday Jan 1st (1865)

Fair, with a moderate breeze from N. Dennis Id
in sight this morning. At 5 P.M. Capt. Hicks and
Mr. Reed went ashore at Bird Island in the
starboard boat and returned again at 7:30 P.M.

Thursday Jan 2nd

Fair, wind moderate from N. Dennis Island in
sight this morning. Bird this evening bearing
N by N 5 miles. Struck a porpoise this evening

Friday Jan 3rd

Fair, moderate wind from N. Bird Id in sight
Saw finbacks

Saturday Jan 4th

Fair moderate wind from N. Saw Bird, Dennis,
and North Ids. Struck seven porpoise from the
bow and saved four of them.
Saw a Stunner
