

Sunday February 9th

X Fair, wind light from N.E. At 9 A.M. Manuel
Francis the Foster, raised a school of sperm whales, one
the bow going to the windward. Entered at 9.30 A.M.

and the starboard and bow boats each got one, and
waist boat got two. The starboard boat got back line
and breast, and lost their whale. Got one codfish.
Bird Island bore S.W. by S.

Monday Feb 10th

Fair, wind light from N.E. Engaged at cuttingubber
last night. Commenced boiling this morning
Boke out water this A.M. Bird Island in sight

Tuesday Feb 11th

Fair, calm most all day, what wind there was
last night from N.E. Engaged boiling. Caught four
large sharks. No land in sight today.

Wednesday Feb 12th

Fair, calm all night and today. Finished boiling last
night one whale turned up to B.L. Washed ship this
A.M. And boke out water this P.M. Saw porpoises.
No land in sight today

Thursday Feb 13th

Fair, calm most all day, what wind there was from
N.W. Engaged at cooping oil this afternoon
No land in sight today

Friday Feb 14th

Fair, with a light air from N.E. course S.W.
Engaged this A.M. in storing oil, temporary in the
staging tier. Stowed down to B.L. oil. Washed ship this
P.M. No land in sight

Saturday February 15th

X Fair, wind light from N.E. Raised Bird Id this
A.M. The starboard boat went ashore at 4 P.M.
and came back at 6 P.M. and brought aboard
a pig and two bunches of bananas, one bunch of
which they got aboard of a ship from Maine.
They saw whales Thursday from Id. while we were drifted
off, they were going to the westward.

Sunday Feb 16th

Fair, wind moderate from N.E. Bird Id in sight
all day. Saw blackfish. Equally this P.M.

Monday Feb 17th

X Cloudy wind moderate N.W. Engaged this
A.M. in breaking out stockfish after hold
Entered to 5 to land timber at Dennis Id.
this afternoon, as to give us more room.
At 11.30 A.M. Mr. Anderson raised a school
of sperm whales, on the weather bow going to
Leeward. 12.30 A.M. boyed, waist and 1st board
boats each got one. Finished cutting at 2.30 P.M.
Port watch went below at 10.30 P.M. Bird Id
back looking on the head. Equally this afternoon
and evening Raised the whaler between Bird and
Dennis Id.

Tuesday Feb 18th

Equally, wind baffling Engaged at cutting
ubber. Catted. The worked at P.M.
Killed a dog this afternoon. Bird Id in sight
John Ames lost his leg very bad with a dog
