

Thursday March 26th 1868

Fair, wind light from N. Starboard went ashore on Liberty. Put down the main topsail and mended and bent it again.

Friday - Mar 27th

Fair, wind light from N. Port watch ashore on Liberty. This is the last Liberty. Billed a hog and scrubbed ship. Put on lime juice on the quarter to whiten the deck. We are going to have some of the assistance of Koko's to visit us.

Saturday - Mar 28th

Fair, most of day. Bird company aboard to dinner. Kell Dupuy and wife, Pascal wife and child, Dural and wife, brought their aboard in two boats, and towed with the Starboard boat. They got a sprinkling comice aboard by a light squall of rain.

Sunday - Mar 29th

Fair, wind light from N. Boat had the crew went ashore on a run, and came aboard at sunset. A boat came from Pahlis this evening with 500 lbs tava and some coconuts.

Monday - Mar 30th

Fair, wind light from N. The mail boxes arrived early this morning, and I got one letter by it. Got underway at 6 AM. Received a small cask of flour. Dennis in sight this evening.

Tuesday - Mar 31st

Fair, wind light from N. Engaged at heaving out after hold for a small pig that got in under the casks. Found the Ship Herald this evening. Bird and Dennis still in sight.

Wednesday April 1st 1868

Fair, wind light from N. Engaged at cleaning the rest of the anchors and painting them. Bird and Dennis still in sight.

Thursday April 2nd

Fair, wind light from N. Frank Biffard fell from aloft this evening, while pulling the main topsail, the bent gasket parted, but did not break any. Found the store in the bottom of the Starboard boat on the yard rolled off on to after hatch. The Span line broke this fall. Bird and Dennis still in sight. Also Ship Herald.

Friday - Apr 3rd

Fair, wind light from N. Lowered the Starboard and went boat for Kahlis, but was not successful in getting fast. Found the Herald this evening.

Saturday - Apr 4th

Fair, calm most of the day. Squally and rainy last night. Dennis still and Herald in sight.

Sunday - April 5th

Fair, wind light from N. All of the Luffhills in sight, also the Herald. Saw a black grampus.

Monday - April 6th

Fair, light air from N. Found the Herald this evening. Bird and Dennis still in sight.

Tuesday - April 7th

Fair, wind light from N. Engaged sending down all the back blocks, and back lashed them. Lowered for Kahlis and went boat got me. All Luffhills still in sight, also the Herald.
