Engaged at sending down foremast and
spikes mended and bent them again
Dennis Id. bore S.E. at 6 P.M.

Tuesday July 7th
Fair, wind strong from S. Current
the foremast sprang, fanning the
sails this evening. The first whales
last Sunday afternoon but they were going
too quick to the windward. They did not
lower for them. Bird Id. bearing N. at 6 P.M.

Wednesday July 8th
Fair, wind light from S.W. Engaged at
heaving out water. Have been gaining the
bark Elizabeth Capt. Paulding of New York
7 mos. but with 150 Bbls. Opium
Elizabeth and Gerald came out of Nahe
this morning. The Gerald took 170 Bbls.
on the Cape de Walpa Banks. Capt. Nickerson
joined her at Nahe. She would not go.

Fair, wind light from S.E. course N.W. S
Engaged at fixing the foremast. Bound for Behanna

this morning. Saw a sulphur bottom this P.M.

by. Wove new maintopgallant sheets and took the
old ones for the fore. Sent down foretopgallant
sail mended it, and bent it again this A.M.

Fair, wind strong from S.W. Steering S.W. Squally
last night. Hauled all the light sails. Hauled
the foremast at 10:30 A.M. 2 points off the weather bow
Engaged at heaving out water this P.M.
Thick a porpoise this evening

Fair, wind light from S.W. Steering full and by
on the port tack. Engaged at heaving out oil
in fore hold coopers oil. commenced to stow back
on the starboard side this afternoon.

Fair, wind light and baffling. Steering full and by
Saw Omora Island this A.M. bearing S.W. E
Engaged at coopers oil and stowing back finished
this evening
