

Wednesday Aug 19<sup>th</sup>

1868

Cloudy wind strong from S. Steering by the wind on the Starboard tack. Saw large number of finbacks this afternoon

Lat 3° 13' S Long 45° 00' E

Thursday Aug 20<sup>th</sup>

Cloudy wind strong from S.E. Steering full and by on the Starboard tack. Saw a large number of finbacks

Lat 3° 08' S Long 45° 40' E

Friday Aug 21<sup>st</sup>

Fair, wind moderate from S. Steering full and by. Painted the bowboat this A.M. Had all the tar out of the house on deck to dry

Lat 3° 10' S Long 46° 35' E

Saturday Aug 22<sup>nd</sup>

Fair, wind moderate from S.E. Steering full and by on the Starboard tack. Broke out water this A.M. scrubbing ship this P.M.

Lat 3° 10' S Long 48° 20' E

Sunday Aug 23<sup>rd</sup>

Fair, wind light from S.E. Steering full and by on the Starboard tack

Lat 3° 19' S Long 50° 13' E

Monday Aug 24<sup>th</sup>

Fair, wind light from S.E. this A.M. this P.M. hauled from S. Steering by the wind on the Starboard tack. Had all the tar out of main hold on deck to dry

Lat 2° 25' S Long 52° 30' E

Tuesday Aug 25<sup>th</sup>

Fair, wind light from S.E. Steering by the wind on the Starboard tack. Saw a white water this evening

Lat 2° 00' S Long 53° 10' E

Wednesday August 26<sup>th</sup>

Fair, wind light and baffling from E and S.E. Tacked ship at 7:30 A.M. and stood on the port tack. 1 P.M. tacked ship again. Saw porpoises

Lat 2° 35' S Long 54° 15' E

Thursday August 27<sup>th</sup>

Fair, wind light and baffling from S.E. to S. Steering full and by. Have been on both tacks

Lat 3° 16' S Long 54° 38' E

Friday August 28<sup>th</sup>

Squally, wind strong from S. Steering by the wind. At 6 A.M. raised the fore and main masts. 3 P.M. double reefed the topsails, and furlled the mainsail. Have been engaged at making coil rope. Caught a porpoise this evening. Bird Id bore S.W. by S at 6 P.M.

Saturday Aug 29<sup>th</sup>

Fair, wind strong from S. Broke out pork this morning. Killed two hogs this afternoon. Bird Id bore S.W. by S at 6 P.M.

Sunday Aug 30<sup>th</sup>

Fair, wind strong from S.E. At 10 A.M. Starboard boat went ashore at Dennis Id with Capt Hicks and returned again at 12. At 1 P.M. went ashore again and carried Mr. Reed, who intends to stay there a few days to recruit his health. He has been sick three weeks with the rheumatism. Boat brought back a new main top gallant sail. And a puppie eight weeks old. Also some mummy apples.
