came aboard this evening. Capt. Hicks and
waist-boats crew went aboard of her.
She is bound to Make this evening after
sunways or else ship more men.

Wednesday Feb 10th

Fair, wind light from N.N.E. Steering S.W.
across the banks, bound to S.W. Light
on soundings all day. Phillonette in sight this A.M.

Thursday Feb 11th

Fair, wind light from N.N.W. Steering S.W.
Filled the scuttle butt this morning, on the
banks all day.

Friday Feb 12th

Fair, wind moderate from N.N.W. Steering S.E.
Make in sight bearing S.E. this evening.

Saturday Feb 13th

Fair, wind moderate from N.N.W. The bark
Elizabeth came out this forenoon. Capt. Hicks
shipped one darkie in Make, only caught
one sunaway, belonging to the Elizabeth.
The American cogit has arrived at Make.
Mended the flyfil and bent it again.

Sunday Feb 14th

Fair, wind light from S.W. course S.E. by E
bound to Baya de Kalka Banks
Lat 6°56' Long 57°00' E

Monday February 15th

Fair, wind light from N.W. Course S.E. by E
Engaged at mending the foretopmast and
foremast and bent flyfil
Lat 7°24' Long 57°48' E

Tuesday Feb 16th

Squally, wind from N.W. course S.E. sent down
the foretopmast and mended and bent it.
Rove new fore and maintopmast haws
shortened sail this evening
Lat 7°56' Long 59°00' E

Wednesday Feb 17th

Squally this A.M. wind strong from N.W. under
double reef topmast. Engaged at making a
sunning for the gundie. Have been on Baya de Kalka
banks
Lat 8°30' Long 60°12' E

Thursday Feb 18th

Squally with plenty of rain, wind from W. under
double reef topmast, all day
Lat 9°00' Long 59°30' E

Friday Feb 19th

Squally with rain, wind from N.W. Broke out
reef and pole, saw blackbird, porpoises, and a finback.
Lat 9°05' Long 59°38' E

Saturday Feb 20th

Squally this A.M. but fair this P.M. wind strong
from N.W. on the starboard tack. have been
on the banks all day. Killed two frogs this
afternoon.
