

Thursday March 16th

1869

Fair. wind light from E.E. was on the banks
at noon. Sounded and got 45 fathoms
Have been steering N.W. this afternoon

Lat 10°33' Long 60°10' E

Friday Mar 17th

Fair. wind light from E.E. this A.M. but calm
this P.M. steering full and by. on port tack.
Engaged at breaking out mullards in after hatch
and water in the main hatch

Lat 10°15' Long 60°15' E

Saturday Mar 18th

Fair. wind light from E.E. steering full and by.
Engaged at skinning. Saw some finbacks.

Lat 11°23' Long 60°09' E

Sunday Mar 19th

Rainy. wind strong from N. have been running to
the N. all this forenoon. this afternoon have been
on the wind heading to the N. until 2 P.M.
when stood to the Eastward. under double reef

Lat 11°30' Long 59°50' E

Monday Mar 20th

Fair. wind light from N. course E. Engaged
at scrubbing ship. Saw porpoise this P.M.

Lat 11°03' Long 60°08' E

Tuesday Mar 21st

Fair. wind light from N.W. steering E. Have been
on the banks all day

Lat 9°54' Long 60°10' E.

Wednesday March 22nd

1869

Fair. wind moderate from N. steering N all this
A.M. but in of again this noon.
Bound across the Banks.

Lat 10°18' Long 60°16' E

Thursday Mar 23rd

Fair. wind light from N.W. steering all ways.
Have been on the banks part of the day.
Engaged at scrubbing the cabin and keel.
They have been filching very bad lately.

Lat 9°55' Long 60°35' E

Friday Mar 24th

Fair. wind light from N. Engaged at various jobs
This afternoon. Sailed the Elizabeth
she has not seen anything in the sperm whale
line since we saw her last. Caught some fish this
evening.

Lat 9°53' Long 60°35' E

Saturday Mar 25th

Rainy. wind baffling. Hauled aback mangled
at 7:30 A.M. and fished until 11 A.M. and
caught large numbers of them. was fishing all
night until 3 A.M. One sail in sight this evening.
No Observations

Sunday Mar 26th

Fair. wind light from N.W. steering full and by.
Engaged a blacksmithing making fish hooks and
fish lines. Elizabeth in sight

Lat 9°40' Long 60°38' E

Monday Mar 27th

Fair. wind light from N. steering full and by.
Engaged this A.M. in breaking out all the firewood
in fore hold and stowing it in after hold. Had a row
with the Capt and mate this afternoon. Lat 9°40' Long 59°55' E
