Equally wind strong from S.E. Steering full and by. Engaged at boiling or maintopail and forail. Finished boiling last night the whole turned up 35 Bbls.

Lat 13°57' N. Long 53°40' E.

Thursday May 5th

Raining. wind light from all points of compass, steering S.E. Engaged at steaming down 32 Bbls of oil this forenoon.

Friday May 7th

Fair wind light from S. Steering full by. Engaged at side sticking the oil maintopail and landing it at fore.

Fair wind light from S. Engaged at hauling out the cutting full to day, raising more rigging. Cashing over the cutting penclasts, and making new main hatch. All the sick's over duty.

Tuesday May 11th

Fair wind light from S.E. steering full and by. Engaged at blacksmithing, clapping and covering black.

Lat 15°00' N. Long 54°38' E.

Wednesday May 12th

Fair wind moderate from S.E. have been steering to N.W. Engaged in taking over the new maintopail and landing it. Saw a steamer to day.
