

Tuesday Aug 3rd

Fair wind moderate from S.E. steering N. until 10 P.M. then hauled on the wind on the port tack. Were ship at 6 P.M. Under double reefed topsails engaged at setting up the jib maintopmast on. Reformed spring stay and mizzen top gallant also having different parts of the rigging.

Lat 16° 01' S Long 54° 12' E.

Wednesday Aug 4th

Fair wind light from S.E. The wind boat went ashore at Sandy Id. this forenoon seeking and came aboard at dusk with numerous articles.

Thursday Aug 5th

Fair wind strong from S.E. Went ashore with the foreboard and two boats or reaching at Sandy Island. And got a great many articles to augment the stores. Got aboard at sunset.

Friday Aug 6th

Squally wind strong from S.E. Commenced under one reefed maintop sail, foretopmast-maintopmast and mizzen stay sail and star board tack.

Lat 15° 00' S Long 54° 00' E.

Saturday Aug 7th

Fair wind clearing & gale from S.E. Commenced to make sail at 8 A.M. gave her the whole maintop sail maintop gallant sail double reefed fore and fore sail, kept her off N.W. for Wake Banks.

Lat 15° 26' S Long 53° 55' E.

Sunday Aug 8th

Fair gale of wind from S.E. steering N. this forenoon N.E. this afternoon. Shipped on sea yesterday forenoon which store foreboard and waist boat foreboard boat and got for foreboard and shipped on sea in the evening. Also filled the storage mast full. Double reefed the fore sail this evening.

Lat 15° 47' S Long 53° 50' E.

Monday Aug 9th

Fair wind moderate from S.E. course N.E. Engaged at repairing the fore and waist which were store the 7th. Under the foreboard boat.

Lat 15° 31' S Long 54° 15' E.

Tuesday Aug 10th

Fair wind light from S.E. steering N.E. until noon when altered the course to N. Engaged at fixing the waist boat and painting her. Saw finbacks this P.M.

Lat 16° 50' S Long 55° 7' E.

Wednesday Aug 11th

Cloudy wind light from S.E. Course N.E. N and N.W. Engaged at making a foretop gallant yard from a spar that was got from Sandy Island. Painted the boat on the fore and fore boat. Saw a large number of finbacks, got the boat ready this forenoon thought they were whales.

Lat 15° 57' S Long 55° 22' E.
