First part of this day began with strong breeze and rough seas. Sailing to while moderating and make some more sails and started cruising also one steamer in sight. Latter pleasant weather crew employed in doing lots of jobs.

This day began with light breeze and fine weather sailing heading N.E. and cruising under all sails out also saw school of Grampers crew employed in breaking out some water and storing down hold one sail in sight. Latter part same weather

Saturday 3

This day light breeze and pleasant weather sailing heading S.E. under all sails out and cruising crew employed in doing little jobs on deck. Latter dying down to a calm also saw Grampers

Lat 34:00

This 24 hours began with very little wind sailing cruising under all sails and steering N.E. pleasant weather could see 12 miles off but nothing around it all. Latter same kind of weather
