This day variable winds sehr cruising under her sails out saw school of whales and got boats ready and lower down L.B. stam for a while looking for whale about half an hour didn't see them again while saw Finbacks and porpoises same three sehr in sight and one steamer latter same weather

This day light breeze and pleasant weather sehr cruising under all sails out crew doing various jobs same three vessel in sight and one steamer in sight latter same.

This day commences with very little breeze sehr cruising under all sails out crew employed in doing ship duty saw school of Finbacks and porpoises also W.A. group in sight latter part same as first one sailing vessel in sight

The 24 hours light breeze and pleasant weather sehr cruising under all sails set also jammed sehr group with 3.00 barrel of oil also one boat in sight round east latter same weather

This day began with very light breeze sehr cruising with all sails set crew doing various small jobs on deck same whaling sehr in sight and four masted schooner W. saw big school of Finbacks and lot porpoises latter same

Pleasant day sehr cruising with all sails out and variable wind running before the winds same whaling sehr in sight saw porpoises also open broke out 8 bags flour
