This 24 hours comes with very little breeze sehr laying round with short sails raised school of sperm whales and lowered three boats down W.B. got fast and iron draw-out chase those whales tell they went out sights and boats came board also Ellen & Swift got 2 whales latter raised another school L.B. got fast and line parted W.B. got one latter blowing hard employed in cut the whale sunbeam in sight
