These day began with light Breezes and fine weather sehr heading by the winds. Crew Employed in doing various ship duty. Saw few sail. at Midnight. Saw 4 masted sehr close by without have any lights. The vessel was near running down.

Thursday 3

These 24 hours comes with strong Breezes and clear weather sehr heading N. by E under all sails out at 10. o'clock. Raised Black Island crew Employed in hauling the chains up. Saw 6 schrs at midnights. Dropped anchor soon in morning. The tug boat towed to the Warff. The end of voyage got in New Bedford. Friday 4 September 1908
