This day strong breezes and fine weather sehr steaming E.S. under all sails but employed in doing ship duty latter same weather

Saturday 23

This 24 hours comes with strong breezes and Pleasant weather sehr heading by the day under all sails out latter same weather

Sunday 24

This day began with strong breezes and a rough seas at midnight sprung up heavy rains and squalls latter blowing hard N.E. gale winds

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Monday 25

First part of this day comes with fresh gale from N.E. sehr laying to under strysails while blowing so hard that tear it up our foresails in two pieces latter part same weather saw one steamer bound East.
