

March 1 First day of this month commencing with light N.E. wind sehr beating up to windward under all sail crew doing ship duty also one sailing vessel in sight bound East latter part of the day much as first Lat 20.04 Long 37.30

March 2 This day began with light breezes and pleasant weather sehr steering N.E. under all sail set crew employed in doing ship duty also saw seven steamers in sight latter part of the day same weather Lat 19.00 Long 37.30

March 3 This 24 hours comes with light winds and fine weather sehr steering by the wind with all sail set crew employed in doing ship duty also spoke with steamer and asked for its longitude 38.25 our longitude 37.58 also saw 10 steamers in sight Lat 18.02 Long 38.25

March 4 This day commences with light winds and pleasant weather sehr steering N.E. under all sail saw 14 steamers also spoke with a small fishing sehr crew employed in rigging Lat 17.50 Long 38.00

March 5 This 24 hours comes with strong breezes wind and fine day sehr steering by the wind with all sail set crew employed in doing various ship works also saw 5 steamers latter part much as first also 2 steamers in sight Lat 17.26 Long 37.30

March 6 First part of this day began with strong breezes and pleasant weather sehr steering by the wind under all sail set crew employed in doing various ship duty at 2.30 P.M. raised a large sperm whale got boat ready and lowered three boat L.B. struck and stove him then S.B. picked up at 11 o'clock. At night the whale was dead and brought to the ship latter pleasant day employed in cutting the whale and cutting gear parted have to stop to repair it Lat 17.50 Long 36.38

March 7 This 24 hours comes with strong breezes and good weather employed in separating the head and cut some 7 blubber latter same got through cutting the body employed in boiling Lat 18.10 Long 36.20

March 8 This day light breezes sehr employed in boiling and cut the blubber in pieces and doing some other jobs also pumping out 2 casks of salt water Lat 18.30 Long 37.40

March 9 This day employed in boiling and took the head in and running oil down and some other duty latter still boiling Lat 18.50 Long 37.50

March 10 Light breezes and pleasant weather sehr employed in boiling the head and stowing oil down while got through boiling employed in clearing up the ship latter pleasant day Lat 19.00 Long 35.57
