April 21 today employed in stowing down and rofing fuel water.

April 22 Doing various jobs and took some shoes from Benjamin belong to Captain Bell.

April 23 Stowing down and painting the ship outside and set up some casks.

April 24 This day Employed in Ship works. Eugene Taylor and Frank. Gracias have a big fight also Eugene cut him with knife in bad place. Doctor say that is dangerous to live.

April 25 This day laying under anchor crew employed in doing various ship works.

April 26 today employed in doing some painting everything quite.

April 27 Employed in ship works took some shoes from shore.

April 28 Doing nothing today getting vessel in shape to sail.

April 29 This day getting ready to sea and sailed off Dominica bound to St Eustatius latter dead calm.

April 30 This day dead calm sehr heading N.W. by N. under all sails saw groups of Guadalupe and roseate in sight.

May 1 First part of this day comes with variable breezes sehr steering for St Eustatius at 5 o'clock dropped anchor crew employed in painting fores and mending foresails.

May 2 This day laying under anchor doing nothing everything quite.

May 3 This day Employed in took some potatoes and herbs and doing some other jobs round the deck.

May 4 This day employed in took potatoes and doing some ship works also getting ready to sea and sailed from St Eustatius at 11 o'clock at night shipped masses gwall Boatmen and George Fisher steward and one Seaman and three green hands.

May 5 This 24 hours commences with strong breezes and rough seas sehr heading N.E. with all sails out crew employed in stowing down the cables latter same weather Lat long.

May 6 This day began with very little wind sehr heading long N.E. by N. with all sails set crew employed in doing various ship duty latter part of the day much as first Lat 21.40 long 61.53.

May 7 This day commences with variable wind sehr heading N.E. by N. on opposite tacks crew employed in doing ship duty latter part wind dying down to a calm saw nothing today Lat 23.50 long 61.00.
