Jan 2 Today fine weather with Variable light wind cruising under short sails also two Stammers in sight and one sail going S.W. Got through boiling employed in running down the sea. Latter same weather Lat 32.30 Long 49.49

Jan 3 This day began with strong Breeze wind and B. vally weather. Sch. cruising under short sails crew employed in ship works saw Grampuss. Latter same weather Lat 32.44 Long 49.49

Jan 4 all this 24 hours comes with strong Breezes wind. Sch. cruising under short sails crew employed in doing various ship duty raised School of Spinn whales and lowered three boats and all got fast and brought the whale to the ship. Getting ready in cutt the whale in fair weather. Lat 32.52 Long 50.05

Jan 5 light winds and fine weather. Sch. employed in boiling saw two sailing vessel also saw great numbers of Grampuss. Lat 33.00 Long 50.30

Jan 6 Today light Variable wind. Sch. cruising under short sails crew employed in running down oil and still boiling. Latter of the day same weather saw Grampuss. Lat 33.20 Long 50.34

Jan 7 Today calm weather and foggy. Sch. laying round with trysails crew employed in running oil down and stowing away the things away. at 4.15 P.M. raised a large Spinn whale and lowered three boats down but the whale was going very fast cannot get him. Latter same weather saw great quantities of Grampuss and porpoiss. Lat 33.10 Long 50.27

Jan 8 calm weather. Sch. laying round crew employed in doing various ship duty. Latter the same. Lat 34.10 Long 50.51

Jan 9 These 24 hours variable winds and fine weather. Sch. cruising under trysails raised Schools of young bulls and lowered three boats down. W.B. struck the other boats chase until they gave it up without any chance employed in cutt the whale in fair weather. Lat 34.30 Long 50.24

Jan 10 This day commences with light Variable wind. Sch. cruising under short sails crew employed in doing various ship works still boiling. Latter much as first. Lat Long

Jan 11 Today comes with light winds and clear weather. Sch. employed in boiling and cruising under short sails also one sail in sight. Latter the same. Lat Long

Jan 12 With light winds. Sch. cruising under short sails. Got through boiling. Crew employed in clearing the Deck. Saw a St. whale also saw Grampuss. Latter same weather. Lat Long
