Jan 14 These 24 hours blowing quite hard from S.W. Sch. laying to, under trysails Latter wind moderately some Lat 32.50 Long 49.16

Jan 15 pleasant weather Sch. cruising under short sails, men at ship works. Saw grampuss Latter of the day same weather Lat 32.30 Long 49.17

Jan 16 Today began with light Breeze wind and pleasant weather Sch. cruising under short sails nothing doing today. Saw School of Blackfishes and grampuss. Latter part of the day same weather Lat 32.50 Long 49.05.

Jan 17 With strong Breeze wind Sch. cruising under trysails. Saw nothing good but grampuss. Crew employed in ship works Latter part of the day same weather Lat 32.52 Long 49.36

Jan 18 These 24 hours comes with strong Breeze wind Sch. cruising under short sails Latter rough seas. doing ship works Lat 33.05 Long 49.11

Jan 19 pleasant weather with light wind Sch. cruising under trysails. Saw grampuss and Blackfishes. crew doing various ship duty Latter much as first Lat 33.20 Long 49.35

Jan 20 Today began with very little winds Sch. cruising under short sails. Saw School of grampuss Latter fine weather saw one steamer Lat 33.50 Long 50.18

Jan 21 These 24 hours light Breeze wind Sch. cruising under trysails raised School of Sperm whales also found thought it was Sperm whales Latter same weather Lat 34.00 Long 50.38

Jan 22 This day comes with light winds and fine weather Sch. cruising on starboard tack under trysails. Saw several schools of grampuss and blackfishes also two steamers in sight Latter same weather Lat 33.48 Long 50.20

Jan 23 With strong Breeze wind and drizzling Sch. cruising under trysails while men at ship works raised a large Sperm whale for with lowered three boats down without any chances on him Latter same Lat 33.40 Long 50.56

Jan 24 Strong Breeze Sch. heading E. by N. under short sails crew employed in various ship duty Latter same weather Lat 32.50 Long 49.40

Jan 25 Today pleasant weather Sch. heading E. by N. and cruising on opposite tack. Saw numbers of grampuss also three steamers in sight Latter fresh Lat 32.30 Long 49.00

Jan 26 This day strong Breeze and rough seas Sch. cruising on opposite tack. Saw grampuss also three sails in sight Latter weather men at ship works Lat 32.10 Long 48.26
