Thu May 14th

This day began with fog SW
wind under short sail later part
rain saw fin back and Black fish
Lat-37-25
Long 73-30

Fri May 15th

This day began with light-ENE
wind under short sail at 5 A.M.
W.B.I. raised a school of whales drop
boats got two cut them in
and start the fires also spoken
a steamer Chronometer out 30
miles slow from G.W. time

Long 37-07

Sat May 16th

This day began with light
NE wind foiling and seeing
oil down later part the same
saw a steamer Lat-36-50
Long 73-44

Sun May 17th

This day began with light-
NE wind finish foiling at 5 A.M.
W.B.I. raised a school of whales drop
boats got one L.B. stove cut him
in and start the fires foiling
and stowed down the oil.
