This day began with light SW wind at 9 A.M. raised a school whales drop boats got one L.B. stove cut him in and start L.B. the fires later part spoken with stove W.A. Graber foilling Lat 37-40 Long 73 00

Tue June 2<sup>th</sup>

This day began with strong SW wind finish foilling at 7 A.M. raised whales drop two boats got two cut them in and start the fires also W.A. Graber got a whale Lat 37-49 Long 73-09

Wed June 3<sup>rd</sup>

This day began with light Easterly wind calm all day boilling and stoved down finish foilling Graber in sight No Obs.
