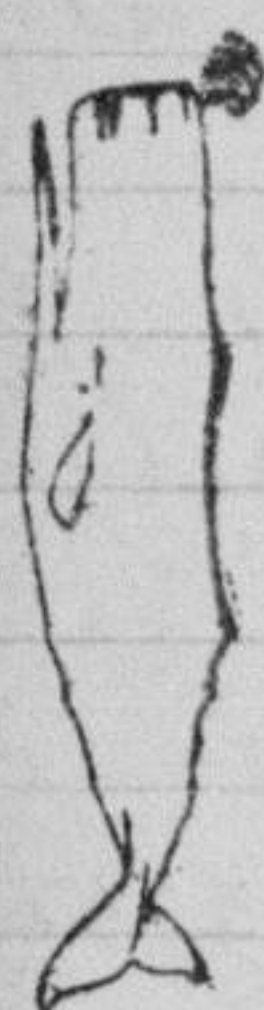




Carleton Bell.
