This day began with light
S. E. wind all sail out at 2 P.M.
none raised a school of whales drop
boats L.B. got fast but lost the
councilt- kill it also saw Graber
a Swift with boats down Lat 36-50
Long 73-30

Thu July 2nd



L.B. stove
w.B. rolled over

This day began with strong
S W wind at 12 A.M. Graber
raised a school of whales drop
three boats W.B. got fast and
roll over L.B. took his line and
got stove lost the whale
Graber and Swift got a
whale Lat 36-40
Long 73-30
