Long 73 38

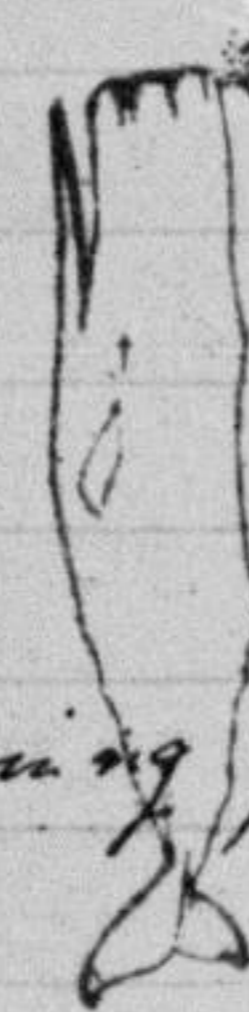
Mon July 6<sup>th</sup>
