Tue Aug 4th

This day began with light- N E.
wind under short-sail later part-
calm saw grampus and a steamer
Lat-3859
Long 00-00

Wed Aug 5th

This day began with strong N E.
wind under short-sail later part-
The same saw grampus Lat 3800
Long 7250

Thu August 6th

This day began with strong
E. N. E wind and rain all day saw
a steamer steering North No Obs.

Fri Aug 7th

This day began with light-
Southerly winds under short-sail
all day later part- the same
steering N E 1/2 E. Lat-3813
Long 72-13
