

Monday Nov. 14th Commenced with a fresh breeze and pleasant weather heading S. S. E. at 4 p.m. lashed ship heading S. E. by E. - Middle part strong breeze double reefed the top sails. Latter part much the same took in the main sail, jib and sprouter heading S. S. E. Lat 22° 33' N. Long 51° 12' W.

Tuesday Nov. 15th Commenced with a moderate Gale the Ship heading E. by S. and S. by E. at sunset close reefed the top sails. Middle part the same - Latter part set the main sail and took it in again. Lat 21° 03' N. Long 55° 11' W.

Wednesday Nov. 16th Commenced with a moderate Gale from the S. the Ship heading E. S. E. under close reefed top sails and fore sail. Middle part very squally with rain took in the fore top sail. Latter part set the fore top sail again so ended. Lat 20° 00' N. Long 58° 11' W.

Thursday Nov. 17th Commenced with a light Gale from the S. with very squally and rainy weather the Ship heading E. S. E. under close reefed top sails and fore sail, one sail in sight, the watch employed breaking out water. Middle part more moderate but one reef out the top sails, set the main sail, jib and sprouter. Latter part fine pleasant weather, spread all sail. Lat 20° 18' N. Long 56° 17' W.

Friday Nov. 18th Commenced with a light wind from N. W. steering S. E. by S. one sail in sight, at 4 p.m. had a heavy squall from the N. W. E. which increased to a Gale, took in all but the close reefed main top sail. Middle and Latter part the same, one sail in sight. Lat 22° 43' N.

Saturday Nov. 19th Commenced with a Gale from the S. E. with thick rainy weather steering S. S. E. at sunset set luffed to the wind under close reefed main top sail and fore top mast and misen stay sails. Middle part the same - Latter part set the close reefed fore top sail. Lat 21° 42' N. Long 52° 20' W.

Sunday Nov. 20th Commenced with a strong wind from the N. E. steering S. E. by S. set the main sail and jib. Middle part took in the main sail and jib. Latter part set them again, saw Black fish. Lat 30° 05' N. Long 50° 21' W.

Monday Nov. 21st Commenced with a strong N. E. wind, steering S. E. by S. under double reefed top sails and misen. Middle part let the reefs out the top sails and set the sprouter. Latter part set the main top gallant sail and jib. Lat 28° 00' N. Long 46° 25' W.

Tuesday Nov. 22nd Commenced with a strong breeze from N. E. and pleasant weather heading S. E. by S. employed in various ways. Middle and Latter part the same. Lat 25° 00' N. Long 45° 25' W.

Wednesday Nov. 23rd Commenced with a strong breeze from E. S. E. the Ship heading S. E. by S. with all sail out, the watch employed breaking out water, one sail in sight. Middle part the same. Latter part heading S. S. E. and S. by E. Lat 23° 58' N. Long 45° 45' W.
